# Founders Day 2006

Founders Day was celebrated on March 4, 2006 at the Adams Alumni Center on the University of Kansas campus in Lawrence, Kansas with the Beta Kappa collegians. Founders Day was attended by 216 alumnae and collegiate members from Greater Kansas City, Lawrence, and KU. Beta Kappa chapter's founding was celebrated, as the chapter was formed 65 years ago in April 1941. Members of the collegiate chapter created a presentation including past and present collegiate member photos. **Donna Hulett**, representing the Leadership Team from Region V, presented the chapter with an anniversary gift, as did the Lawrence alumnae. 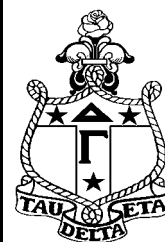
