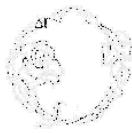

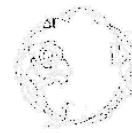

Kansas City area DGs celebrated the holidays in December at the beautiful home of Janise Naughton (Mu). The event was catered by our own Jenny Steffens (Mu) of Occasions by Jenny Steffens (www.OccasionsKC.com). Jenny has shared one of her delicious recipes with us.

Jenny Steffens' Puffy Pastry Pecan Sticky Buns

- 1/2 cup pecans, chopped
- 2 tablespoon unsalted butter, melted and cooled
- 1/3 cup light brown sugar, lightly packed
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 package (2 sheets) frozen puff pastry, defrosted

Preheat the oven to 400 degrees. Prepare a baking sheet with cooking spray. Lightly flour a wooden board or stone surface. Unfold one sheet of puff pastry with the folds going left to right. Brush the whole sheet with half of the melted butter. Leaving a 1-inch border on the puff pastry, sprinkle each sheet with the brown sugar, cinnamon, and pecans. Starting with the end nearest you, roll the pastry up snugly like a jelly roll, finishing the roll with the seam side down. Trim the ends of the roll about 1/2 inch and discard. Slice the roll in 6 equal pieces, each about 1 1/2 inches wide. Place each piece, spiral side up on the baking sheet. Repeat with the second sheet of puff pastry. Bake for 20 minutes, until the sticky buns are golden to dark brown on top and firm to the touch.
